## Newspaper Access

The University of Regina provides access to the database PressDisplay. You can access newspapers such as the Leader-Post and the Globe and Mail, as well as thousands of other publications from around the world. Link to PressDisplay:

The database does not have persistent links to specific titles, so you will need to select the newspaper or magazine each time you visit the database. You can browse publications by country or use the search box at the top. If you are looking to read the Regina Leader-Post or the Globe and Mail, they are always listed under “Librarian Picks” on the right sidebar of the main page.

The database is available while you are on campus, however, if you would like to access the database off campus, you will need to authenticate your UofR account. You can either use your URegina username and password (the same one as for GroupWise, UR Courses, etc) or by using your employee card barcode plus your last name.
