AGENDA ITEM #1: Two JDC course proposal	Follow up action
<p>The feedback of the Undergraduate Program Committee was sought on a proposed new selected topics course, Theory and Application of Leadership, which would be available to students who had previously participated in the JDC West games (through the previously approved selected topics course BUS 435AQ). Students in this course would participate in JDC West as team leaders. Sylvain Charlebois explained the course and how it would interrelate with BUS 435AQ.</p> <p>Several committee members expressed concerns. Three major areas of concern were identified:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The draft course outlines provided by Sylvain appeared to include overlap between BUS 435AQ and the proposed leadership course.</li> <li>• The leadership course would be available only to students who had previously participated in JDC west and therefore not available more widely to students.</li> <li>• There would be interaction among students in the two courses and the BUS 435AQ students would be subjects of the leadership application for the students in the leadership course. The possible dynamics between the leaders and the led would be uncertain.</li> </ul>	<p>Morina to draft a document about the proposed selected topics course and the issues raised by members of the Undergraduate Program Committee.</p>
