Report from the Undergraduate Program Committee to Faculty Council (February 13, 2009)

The Undergraduate Program Committee recommends the approval of the following motion.

Moved that BUS 007 be added as a prerequisite for BUS 375.

Rationale and Background

BUS 007 (Business Computer Lab), per the course calendar description, must be taken by students during their first semester in the BBA. However, with registration through UR Self-Service, it is not possible to ensure this is done. There have been a number of cases recently where students have had their graduation from the BBA delayed due to not having successfully completed BUS 007, therefore being unable to register for BUS 400 (Business Strategy). The prerequisites for BUS 400 are all core business administration courses and a minimum of 90 credit hours.

Making BUS 007 a prerequisite for BUS 375 (Managing Information Systems) will help avoid this situation to some degree. BUS 375 is a core business administration course and students will become aware earlier that they have not satisfied the requirement to complete BUS 007.

The committee also considered making BUS 007 a prerequisite for a BUS 200-level course but this would cause difficulties for students taking the course as part of another program.

Current prerequisite for BUS 375:

BUS 210 (or ADMN 210), BUS 250 (or ADMN 250), BUS 275 (or ADMN 275), BUS 288 (or ADMN 288), and BUS 290 (or ADMN 290).

*Note: Students may only receive credit for one of BUS 375, ADMN 375, and ADMN 435AI.

Suggested prerequisite for BUS 375:

BUS 007, BUS 210 (or ADMN 210), BUS 250 (or ADMN 250), BUS 275 (or ADMN 275), BUS 288 (or ADMN 288), and BUS 290 (or ADMN 290).

*Note: Students may only receive credit for one of BUS 375, ADMN 375, and ADMN 435AI.
